



Harvest Houses Governing Rules & Regulations

First 30 days Residents are under house restrictions, they may only leave for acquiring any legal documents needed, court or probation & parole mandated requirements and any other agencies mandated requirements or meetings.

Must attend first two weeks of intensive outpatient therapy.

May Leave for job search with approved persons, also may leave for work during this period.

Must be accompanied by approved personnel, must go to Mark Twain Behavioral Health evaluation.

Any other activity must be approved by house managers, men and women directors or executive director.

First 120 days or when you are eligible to go to next phase

Phase 1

5 approved meetings and one Church service. One of these meetings being a bible study. Total should meet six by Sunday.

Any mandated programs by court or probation and parole.

Must attend any requirements of MTBH or Preferred Health, etc.

After 120 days to 18 months, or when eligible to go to next phase

Phase 2:

Go down to 3 approved meetings and one Church Service. One of the meetings being a bible study. Total should be four by every Sunday.

All other requirements of house rules, legal requirements and treatment programs.

Phase 3: 18 months or when eligible to phase up

You go down to 2 approved meetings and one Church Service. One of the meetings must be a bible study. Total of 3 every Sunday.

Curfew for Phase 3 for Men

- Sunday Through Thursday 11p.m.
- Fridays and Saturdays 12a.m.

Meetings:

All meeting requirements must be met each week per phase

Must have the signature of chairperson.

Approved meetings are:

AA, NA, extra church, bible studies, mentors and any other meetings that have been approved by Harvest Outreach Board.

Meeting sheets must be turned into house managers by 9:00 pm Sunday nights.

One approved church service, and bible study.

House bible study, and house meeting are mandatory.

House Bible study counts as a meeting.

Work, illness or approval from the executive director are only accepted reasons to be absent.

Curfew at women's house

ALL PHASES

Sunday -Thursday 9pm (will make exception for special events)

Friday and Saturday -10pm(will make exception for special events)

Phase 1&2: (Men's House)

Sunday-Thursday 10 pm.

Friday-Saturday 11 pm

Phase 3:(Men's House)

Sunday-Thursday: 11 p.m.

Friday-Saturday 12 a.m.

1st violation - breathalyzer, UA next day, \$10 fine \$10.00 for U.A test

2nd violation—breathalyzer, UA next day, 14-day restrictions, \$25. Fine \$10.00 for U.A. cup

3rd violation—exited

Overnights and weekend passes:

Must have program fees and fines paid in full

Must be in good standing at the house (no disciplinary actions)

Must be in good standing with any legal requirements and treatment programs

Must be in an approved place

Must have approval from parole officer

Must have final approval from Harvest Houses Director or Executive Director.

Must Pay \$10.00 for U.A. test before leaving for the overnight. Failure to do so will result in resident not being approved for the overnight.

Must Go to Men's/Women's House manager for approval for overnights, upon returning from overnights must submit to a drug test before reentry into the houses.

Before entry back into the house/s must have verified negative drug test/BAC.

Chores:

Each person is assigned a chore duty to be performed daily.

Chore when finished must meet house manager approval

Every resident will be assigned a chore duty for the duration of their residency with Harvest Outreach.

Rooms:

Can not enter other residents' rooms/staff rooms without permission or the individual present.

You cannot add anything to walls without permission

Must be clean, picked up and beds made each day. Harvest House management has the right to inspect rooms at any time

Fines:

Entering a room without permission: \$25.00

Missing approved church \$35.00

Missing House bible study \$35.00

Missing house meeting \$35.00

Leaving Stove or Oven on \$50.00

Smoking/Vaping in house \$50.00

Missing other required meetings \$5.00 for each occurrence

Chores \$5.00 fine and double each time it's not done

All fines must be paid within 2 weeks, or they double

Program fees:

\$400 Sobriety deposit first month

\$400.00 a month or \$100.00 a week for program fees

\$440.00 monthly or \$110.00 weekly for Men's rooms on First floor and in the sanctuary

Must stay at least two weeks ahead or subject to fines

Final Instructions:

Absolutely no alcohol or drug use permitted

Absolutely no fraternization between men and women at the houses

All medications must fall under Harvest Outreach guidelines and acceptance

Constant violation of rules and regulations can result in disciplinary actions decided by the leadership including 30-day restrictions or removal

Any new charges obtained in the duration of stay within Harvest Outreach Ministry will result in being existed.

Any contact with Law Enforcement is to be made aware of to the Supervisors and the Directors of the houses immediately.

Loitering on the property of individuals not in the houses under a form of supervision unless approved by the dictates is prohibited.

Residents are not permitted to have a job selling/handling alcohol while maintaining residency in the home.

The personal numbers of staff in the Ministry are not to be given to anyone under any circumstances unless approved by the individual before. The ministry telephone number is **573-822-5858**.

Absolutely no stealing of any form is allowed and will result in immediate exit from the houses. This includes but is not limited to:

Personal property

Money

Food items

Personal hygiene items

Vapes, or other nicotine

Harvest House property of any form

Medications

Electronics

And anything not owned by you. If found taking said items it will result in exiting of the house, probation/parole officer contact and authorities included.

All residents must sign release with probation and parole and treatment centers for UA results and treatment plans

All residents are under the authority of Harvest Outreach Ministries and their dictates.

Harvest Outreach is a faith based Christian organization. Our mission has always been to save lives and share Jesus Christ praying that God will do a work in their hearts through the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ.
